



REGISTER TO VOTE

THE STEPS TO KNOW

Are you a person with a disability?

Are you an United States citizen?

Will you be 18 years of age or older at the of the next election?

Have you resided in Colorado 22 days immediately before the election in which you want to vote?

If you answered YES to all these questions, you are eligible to VOTE.

Follow these steps to check your registration or register for the first time

Are you registered to vote?

Vote by sending in or dropping off your Mail-In Ballot by 7pm on Election Day

Online

-Visit www.govotecolorado.com
-Update or complete your registration
-You will be automatically be sent a mail-in ballot

OR

By Mail

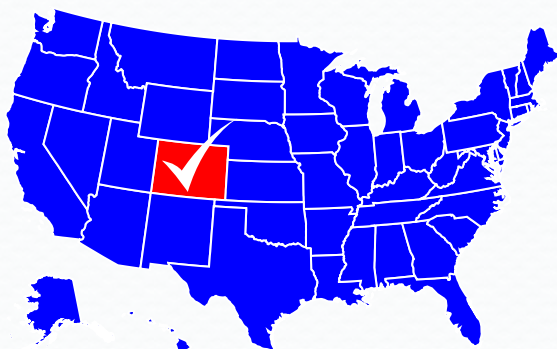
-Send you voter registration form to your County Clerk and Recorder 8 days before the election, to receive a mail-in ballot.

OR

In-Person

-You can register at any Department of Motor Vehicles.
-You can also register before or on the day of the election at any place offering voter services.
